

Staton Strides for Success in COLOR fun run FAQ



Q: I need help or have questions about logging on to register my student?

A: If you participated in Staton Strides last year, the login is the exact same email and password. If you are new, you will need to create an account. If you are experiencing any problems, please email ss4shelp@gmail.com.

Q: What date and time is the run?

A: Saturday, March 26th at 8:30am or 9:30am. There are no assigned times for grade levels, so come to whatever start times works best for your family!

Q: Are family members and friends allowed to participate?

A: Yes! If you are not a Staton student or staff member and want to participate in the run, please donate \$60 cash or check and mark the additional runner box on the donation form. The first 200 additional runners will receive a run pack. We encourage spectators to come and cheer on your runners. Spectators will be allowed anywhere along the run path except in the middle of the color areas.

Q: Are younger siblings allowed to participate for free?

A: Yes, any younger siblings of a Staton student (5 and under) can participate for free.

Q: Will parking be available?

A: The parking lot will be closed for the run festivities. If you live near the school, we encourage you to walk or ride your bike. The bike rack (near the top kiss n go) will be open to store your bike during the run. Park at Tree Top park or on the street where you can find legal parking.

Q: Are pets allowed?

A: We love our furry friends, but because it is on school grounds, no pets are allowed.

Q: Are bikes, scooters and strollers allowed at the run?

A: No bikes or scooters are allowed on school grounds, please lock them up at the bike rack area (near the top kiss n go lane). Strollers will be allowed for spectators to walk along and cheer on the runners, but not through the actual run course as there will be a lot of color thrown.

Q: What should I wear to run?

A: Wear tennis shoes, your SS4S gear or anything you don't mind getting color powder on and sunglasses to protect your eyes. You may consider a gator or something to cover your mouth through the color throw stations. We encourage you to bring a water bottle as well. We will have a water fill station to fill your bottles.
